To Whom it May Concern:

Please be advised that based on the information available to us from our raw material suppliers, the current [REDACTED] films do not contain by manufacture, any of the below listed materials above the regulatory threshold. The standard was set forth by the CONEG (Coalition of Northeastern Governors) regulation in 1994, which limits the listed heavy metals content to a maximum of 100 ppm in combined total. To the best of our knowledge, none of these materials are generated during production. Because we do not expect these materials to be present above the levels specified, we have not specifically conducted any analysis on our raw materials or end product to measure for these materials.
