The likelihood of the level of lead being any higher in Exact Index than the <2 ppm in our Astrobrights is highly unlikely as it is made from the same pulps and chemicals and would contain much less dye. I personally am not sure why we even have to concern ourselves with phthalates as these typically come into play in plastics like PVC and other things from which toys would be made. There might be some trace amounts in the latex in coated papers, but the bulk of our products are uncoated like Exact Index.
